Scope and Responsibilities:

When Tesoro began preliminary design for their golf course maintenance complex, they came to Richard K. Davis Construction Corporation (RKDCC) for their knowledge and experience in both the design and building of such facilities. Because the proposed complex was to be located immediately adjacent to both the Tennis and Racquet Club and Discovery Center, the design had to incorporate not only the full range of golf maintenance functions but also high level of aesthetics. To meet the cost budget for the project, RKDCC proposed the use of a pre-engineered metal building structural system skinned with barrel tile shaped metal roofing panels and masonry exterior walls stuccoed in an old world texture. This provided Tesoro with the large open spaces needed for equipment storage and maintenance while complimenting the Mediterranean Tuscan design of it's surroundings, all at a reasonable cost.
