Scope and Responsibilities:

By utilizing our **Design/Build Service**, this church's Property Development Committee was able to direct us in the design of a complete Master Plan for their beautifully wooded lot. With a strong focus on preserving the natural characteristics of the site, we laid out a four-phase Development Plan; the first being this multipurpose facility. Our Design Team created this architectural look to blend with the surrounding residential neighborhoods and satisfy the requirements of the St. Lucie West Architectural Review Board. The completed project includes a sanctuary that seats 350 and converts to a fellowship hall with adjoining offices, classrooms and kitchen. By incorporating the various exterior elements of a steeple, architectural metal standing seam roof, ornamental brackets/moldings and the combined use of horizontal lap and clapboard sidings, a distinctive New England aesthetic welcomes the community to come and worship.
