Scope and Responsibilities:

Rapid growth in Port St. Lucie led to First United Methodist Church expanding its services for its diverse congregation. A new facility was centrally located on the existing church campus where it sets the architectural and aesthetic standard for the prominent Prima Vista frontage and future upgrades to existing structures. Ministry use includes eight spacious classrooms, a sanctuary/vestibule with capacity for 670, and all administrative offices. Exposed timber roof framing, ornamental aluminum accents and standing seam metal roofing make this building the focal feature it was designed to be.
