Scope and Responsibilities:

One of the first projects on the Main Street Fort Pierce agenda was to restore the historic Fort Pierce City Hall building in downtown Fort Pierce. Local contractor of choice, Richard K. Davis Construction Corporation, oversaw the entire renovation process, working with the architect to refit the building as a special events hall and professional office. By using In-House Crews in conjunction with local subcontracted craftsmen, we maintained quality and cost control over the project, restoring all exterior ornamental detailing, refinishing the original windows and making them operable again, bringing new life to the Dade County pine flooring and interior stairs, as well as building exterior stairs to complement the original building exterior while simultaneously satisfying contemporary fire codes.
