Scope and Responsibilities:

When the Indian River Community College Foundation stepped up to meet the Fort Pierce campus' need for student housing, they turned to the **Design/Build Service** of Richard K. Davis Construction Corporation to handle the project. In partnership with the architect, we transformed the expressed needs of the IRCC Foundation into a village of six two story dormitories, each housing eight efficiency apartments that allow four students to have their own bedrooms and bathrooms, and share a common kitchen/living area. Construction was completed in time for students to move in for the 1994/1995 school year.
