Scope and Responsibilities:

Following the devastation that the 2004/2005 hurricane seasons had on existing roofing systems, many building owners determined to invest in the durability and weather tightness that architectural standing seam metal roofing systems provide. Westside Baptist Church was one such owner, opting to replace their existing asphalt shingle roofs with **Butler Manufacturing's VSR Standing Seam Metal Roof** on their original Sanctuary and Classroom Buildings, structures that Richard K. Davis Construction Corporation (RKDCC) had built years earlier.
